Michelle Leann "Shelly" Davis, 58, of Winfield, Kansas, passed away Sunday morning, November 26, 2017 at Wesley Medical Center in Wichita.



Born September 4, 1959 in Landstuhl, Germany, she was the daughter of Galen and Correne (Kling) Green. She was raised and received her education in Wichita, graduating from Wichita Southeast High School in 1977.

Shelly was united in marriage to Mark Davis on November 28, 1980 at the Presbyterian Church in Wichita. The couple made their first home in Atlanta, Kansas, before moving to Winfield in 1985. Shelly returned to school at Cowley County Community College in Arkansas City and later transferred to Southwestern College in Winfield where she graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing. She began her career at Via Christi St. Francis Hospital in Wichita and worked in several area nursing homes including Winfield Good Samaritan, Winfield Rest Haven and Cumbernauld Village.
